The Amazon is a new area of ministry for Allow. We have contacts in the area where Colombia, Peru and Brazil come together.



The Amazon overflows every year as rainy season begins, but this year the flooding has been worse than most of the people can remember. Even though this church is built on high pilings, the water is 3 feet deep inside. Many people are literally living on their kitchen tables. We hope to establish a child sponsorship program and pastor training program in this area.
