Earthquakes in Nepal

**As tremors and aftershocks continue,
uncertainty and fear have become the
way of life...**



After more than 15 years of ministry together, Allow has many close
and faithful relationships with pastors and partners.

Earthquake relief funds are being used to help them survive and
for those within the reach of their ministries.

Many little village churches like this one will need to be rebuilt.

Medical Clinics *in Nepal*

Medical clinics are one of the most effective projects we do for evangelism. We take **doctors** with a team into villages where the people have very little access to medical care. The people come to the church to see the doctor, fully understanding that the Christians have brought this for them because we care.

Pastors move among the people, building relationships, offering Bibles and tracts, inviting them to the church and praying with them for their need. The Jesus video plays during the day for the people who are waiting, and after dark, the big screen is set up and typically the whole village comes to watch. In the days following the clinic, the pastors follow up with the people—and the churches grow.

What we need for medical clinics:

Vitamins!

Almost everyone in the clinics need vitamins. Church collections or gifts from individuals are all needed.

Bibles!

We want to provide a Bible to those who show an interest in the Lord and salvation tracts to everyone who comes.

Medicines!

Medicines are provided free of charge. They are bought within the country under the supervision of our doctor.

Doctors!

We need doctors to travel with us for this ministry. We can connect you to a doctor on our board for information.

Lasang's mother died and her father is unable to work due to advanced tuberculosis. Her family was homeless. Now Lasang is living in one of our children's homes. She needs a sponsor.
