KMH-16 Lasang half orphan

Mother died and father is unable to work due to advanced tuberculosis. Family was homeless. Lasang is now in one of our children's homes.



MAG-11 Swostika

Very poor family in a fishing village. Family has no home and no other job, except fishing. Swostika cannot attend school without a sponsor.



CTW-103 Abraham

Father is a village pastor and also works laying bricks and also works laying bricks. The family has no land. Abraham needs a sponsor for school.

Medical Clinics *in Nepal*

Medical clinics are one of the most effective projects we do for evangelism. We take **doctors** with a team into villages where the people have very little access to medical care. The people come to the church to see the doctor, fully understanding that the Christians have brought this for them because we care.

Pastors move among the people, building relationships, offering Bibles and tracts, inviting them to the church and praying with them for their need. The Jesus video plays during the day for the people who are waiting, and after dark, the big screen is set up and typically the whole village comes to watch. In the days following the clinic, the pastors follow up with the people—and the churches grow.
